Comments 1. reworking (all regrinding) distinguishable by lack of brownish patina which covers rest of cell. Most of the re-ground areas are also faceted. On this basis, the poll, blade & side edges have all been ground down. The effect on the sides has been to narrow the side edge facet - the right edge is almost pointed at the poll end. Further faceting underneath the patina probably indicates earlier regrinding.

2. Sliced. 173 (Wilt 50)
