2. edges recently worn
3. Darbishire 1872, p. 253, no. 5. I cannot see the "traces (in a glazed polish) of this tool having been fastened on to a handle." There is a horizontal line, separating darker above a lighter colour below, c. 6 cm from poll edge on front face, but this looks like the stain left by a label. However, there is a distinct area on blade (though clearer on front than on back) which is lighter than rest of stone. Its shape suggests that something glutinous was squeezed over the blade edge. The edge is straight + recently worn.
