  - BLACON = 2. Not very symmetrical.
  - Zone of pecking is more diffuse on back face, which mostly has a ground surface. It rather looks as if grinding post-dates pecking, though remnant scars suggest the celt was, at least initially, shaped by flaking. It may be that pecking in fact post-dates grinding.
