Comments 1. Flint. 7/8/10

2. faces are fresh + look unpatinated, but all edges seem to be worn. Side + poll edges could have been ground, but if so, this is obscured by wear.

3. grinding on back face is more extensive than on front. This is because a large flat facet (cleavage surface of rock, or flat scar facet) has been ground lightly.

4. Arch. Camb. 6, 1926, 199-200. Fig. shows front face. Found 'near a tree stump of the ancient forest bed'.
