Flattened corner on left side of blade may derive from original shape of roughness, but seems were likely to have been caused by damage, the flake scar on the back, + the edge being ground subsequently. However, however, there are grinding phase is discernible. So this may be the cell's original shape.

3. P. 1428: ungrouped stone of darkified glassy rhyolite.
