2. W.C. Lilly, 1972. Annual address to the Connecticut Naturalists' Field Club, read at Glenwater, April the 27th, 1890. Proc. Conn. Nat. F.C. 10, 1-38. p. 33 - lists stone implements in Mr. G.B. Witts' collection, including 4 celts from Andoverford, 90012 is illustrated (plate III, no. 13), but not 90010 or 90011. Of the 4 listed, one other is illustrated - not one of those 4 celts. No other information is given than provenance. It seems likely that these came from a collection - perhaps brought in Andoverford? See also Museum Briny p. 73. Evers et al. 1972 (p. 272) do not consider this possibility.
